Since April 2008, Dr. Andreas Gruchow has been a Member of the Managing Board of Deutsche Messe in Hannover. He is responsible for all global activities, i.e. all exhibitions and events outside Germany, the abroad subsidiaries, worldwide representatives, global alliances and co-operations. He is also a Member of the Supervisory Board of the Shanghai New International Expo Centre SNIEC in Pudong, China. Additionally, he is responsible for all CeMAT events in Hannover and abroad, for EMO and for all B2C events of Deutsche Messe / Fachausstellungen Heckmann.

Since 2008 he is a Member of the Board of Directors of UFI and since November 2011 also a Member of the Executive Committee of UFI.

Also since 2008 he is a Member of the Board of EMECA. From 2011 to 2012 he was Vice President EU Relations, President from January 2013 to December 2014, since then Vice President Treasurer.

Earlier, he was Senior Vice President of the International Trade Fairs at Deutsche Messe and in charge of events like DOMOTEX, LIGNA, BIOTECHNICA and INTERSCHUTZ and all guest events in Hannover.

He joined Deutsche Messe in March 1994 as Director of the world exposition “EXPO 2000” in Hannover. From 1998 to 2000 he worked parallel as a Senior Vice President of the EXPO 2000 Hannover GmbH.

Dr. Andreas Gruchow was born in 1964. He studied at the University of Hannover and graduated with Ph.D. (Dr.-Ing.) in Mechanical Engineering.
