❖ 课程简介

此项目会邀请在亚洲知名展馆任职的 CEO 和高级经理为讲师,结合在中国 运营展馆的实际情况,安排三天的课程。课程会为学生提供上好的学习环境、 与业内资深人士的交流机会、课程考核以及毕业证书。课程内容包括展馆营销 管理策略、展馆风险管理、展馆安保管理、日常运营管理、人力资源管理以及 领导力培养等等。课程主要以中文讲授并提供课程资料的中文翻译版本。
