The entry should cover all parts of the process involved from conception through to delivery.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Entries will be evaluated based on the following elements:

- · Clearly defined and measurable objectives
- · The project or concept description
- · The implementation timeframe
- The value and advantages delivered
- The scale of actual and future benefits.

APPLICATION PROCESS

By 15 March 2023

All entries will be reviewed by the UFI Operations and Services Working Group.

Three finalists will be selected from the entries received. The jury's decision is final, and no justification for any decision will be provided. The three finalists will be asked to prepare and present a detailed presentation of their entry at 2023 Operations and Services Forum to be held on "date"
