Quick background, nature and general objectives of the program



The paper we use is a composite : polyester, cellulose and fiber glass.

The composition answers our criteria of lightness, light diffusion, dimensional stability, humidity resistance, and fire resistance. But it is not recyclable.

This paper is manufactured for us exclusively and we order more than 30 tons a year.

It replaces wood, plastic, metal, and heavy structure. We call it Drop Paper.

Since many years we try to find solutions to recycle after its temporary use. We collect our wastes of material in house and used decoration from our customers.

After 4 years of development the key lessons learns:

- Importance of the scalability of the process
- Involvement of all the customers base
- Importance of the eco conception
- Communicate, allways communicate
- Share difficulties, importance of the collaborative design





- A challenge to improve our capability from 1,6 tons to 30 tons a year.
- Development of side products of the Drop Cake
- Development of 100 % recyclable papers such as Hemp Paper and linen Paper to supplement historical Drop Papers.
- Always more creativity through sustainability.


